## We're remodeling Carsonville Chapel

For most of its life, the Carsonville Chapel served as a house of worship. When it was moved to Camp Findley in the mid-20th century, the building was placed with love and care on its current foundation. Over the years, the Chapel has been utilized for many different tasks at Camp Findley, including gathering space, storage, arts and crafts, records retention, and worship.

In 2007, the Camp Findley Board of Directors, along with dedicated volunteers from the Bemus Point UMC and the Friends of Findley, wanted to re-

store Carsonville Chapel to a place of worship - holy ground! For the past two years, over \$25,000 has been donated for Phases 1 and 2 to be completed! We thank God for the time, resources, and talents from innumerable skilled volunteers and contractors.

### Here's what's been done:

**Phase 1**—gutting the building, reframing walls and floors, installation of a heating system and insulation, rewiring for lights and A/V equipment.

**Phase 2**—replacing the roof, installing new lighting, painting walls, installing new carpet and doors, installing railings and trim work.

## NOW FOR PHASE 3...

The plan to complete the remodeling at Carsonville Chapel includes:

- A building addition on the southeast corner of the building, by the Prayer Garden, including roofing and extension of the current heating system
- Two new handicap-accessible bathrooms
- A new kitchenette for beverage and snack service
- A new septic tank and connections to the existing drainage field
- Vinyl siding for the Chapel
- New chairs and equipment for the worship space
- New exterior walkway and lighting for safety
- A new handmade cross for the worship space
