

## *Camp Findley*

### **What To Bring To Camp Check List**

\_\_\_\_\_ **Bible**, notepad, pen or pencil, stationary/postcards, stamps, camera, bug repellent, book for “quiet time” reading, flashlight and batteries

\_\_\_\_\_ **Clothes**: Jeans/pants (at least 1 pair), shorts for each day, light colored shirts (no spaghetti strap tops for girls), sweatshirt or light jacket, socks, underwear, pajamas, raincoat or poncho, hat, laundry bag

\_\_\_\_\_ **Foot Wear**: At least 1 pair of tennis or athletic shoes along with sandals and flip-flops to wear to the waterfront and in shower

\_\_\_\_\_ **Swimwear**: A swimsuit that you would be comfortable swimming, skiing, tubing, or doing other water sports in, beach towel, sunscreen (no bikinis please)

\_\_\_\_\_ **Personal Items**: Bath towel, washcloth, toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, comb, hairbrush, deodorant

\_\_\_\_\_ **Bedding**: Sleeping bag or linen and blanket for twin size bed, pillow and pillowcase

\_\_\_\_\_ **Other**: Any medication that will or may need, either prescription or over-the-counter. Medications should be brought in their original containers inside a zip-lock bag and clearly labeled with your child’s name and camp name on it. Medication will NOT be given to any camper without a Health Form completed and signed by your licensed health care provider.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Money**: All money for Snack Bar purchases will be collected upon the camper’s arrival. Any unspent money will be returned to the camper at check-out.  
\* The gift shop will be open at registration and again at checkout but not during the week. Your child will NOT need money for the gift shop during the week.

**DO NOT BRING**: Radios, CD Players, Cell phones, Video Games, mp3 players or other electronic devices. You will not need them while you are here.

## *Staying in Touch with your Camper*

**MAIL:** Mail should be addressed as follows: Name of Camper, Name of Camp they are attending (Adventure, Discovery A, Sr. High, etc.), Camp Findley, 2334 Sunnyside Rd, Clymer, NY 14724.

- **Please DO NOT send candy or food items** in the mail or with your child to camp. These items end up in your child's sleeping area and bring uninvited critters to join them in the cabin.
- Parents of younger campers, if you would like your child to write to you or others during their stay at camp please send the addresses with them and make sure they know how to address an envelope. Or send the envelopes pre-addressed. This would be a great opportunity to practice an important skill with your child.

**TELEPHONE:** It is not realistic for our campers to call home while at camp. If you have questions as to how your child is doing, senior camp staff will be glad to talk to you about your child. Please note that if there is any type of concern with your child, you will be contacted by the camp staff.
